**Very Important Instructions to the Colleges and Candidates: ---**

- After the end of admission process all admitting colleges will upload the Provisional allotment letter of all admitted candidate duly signed by the Candidate and the Admission committee of the college along with college Fee receipt and Candidate's College ID card before 5<sup>th</sup> May 2021 under any condition.

## **Institute Level Round Admission Guidelines**

1. Colleges should Admit the Candidates in their Colleges, as per the system generated Institute Level Common Meritlist per the Candidates' Eligibility & category Candidature Type -wise Vacancies. The newly registered candidates will be placed below the already registered candidates as per the norms given in the information brochure.
2. Priority Order Candidate's Admission:
  - i. If vacancy is available in the college, then admit the candidates of same Quota (MS/OMS), as per Institute Level Merit List.
  - ii. If there is vacancy in category allocate the seat to the same category n candidate as per the system generated merit list.
  - iii. If the Candidate of the same category is not available in the Merit list, then the college can convert the seat to the nearest category as per the category groups mentioned in the information brochure. If all category candidates are exhausted, then all remaining seats are to be filled in though Inter SE Merit.
  - iv. If there is vacancy and if same quota Candidate is not available, then convert the Quota (MS to OMS or OMS to MS these seats shall be filled in by Inter Se Merit considering all the candidates as open Candidates.) and admit the Candidate.
  - v. how to fill the NRI/OCI PIO vacant seats in Unaided and Unaided Minority Colleges: - The seats reserved for this NRI or Foreign Student or OCI or PIO quota remains vacant, those vacant seats may be filled in by the Institution, from the Eligible Candidates: Provided that while filling of these vacant seats the preference shall be given to the Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit.
  - vi. How Fill in NRI seats in Government/ Aided/Aided Minority Institutions: -  
If the seats remain vacant from NRI, OCI, PIO Foreign Student Candidates Quota, it will be filled from the All India Candidature Candidates on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit by Competent Authority.
  - vii. How to fill Vacant All India Quota (OMS) seats in government /Aided/ unaided Institutions. If the seats remain vacant from All India (OMS) Candidates Quota, it will be filled from the Maharashtra State (MS) Candidature from Open Category Candidates only strictly on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit by Competent Authority.
  - viii. How to fill Vacant All India Quota (OMS) seats in government /Aided/ unaided Institutions. If the seats remain vacant from All India (OMS) Candidates Quota, it will be filled from the Maharashtra State (MS) Candidature from Open Category Candidates only strictly on the basis of Inter-Se-Merit by Competent Authority.
  - ix. **Economically Weaker Section (EWS) seats will be filled in by the EWS candidates only. If there are no EWS candidates available in the system generated merit list, the remaining seats will remain vacant and will not be transferred to any other category in any case.**
  - x. Minority Quota Seats: The stages of allotment are as follows, —  
Stage- I: The seats under minority quota in the minority institution linguistic or religious shall be allotted to the candidate belonging to respective Minority candidates.  
Stage- II: If the Seats remains vacant shall be allotted to the Maharashtra State candidature candidates.  
Stage- III: If the seats remains vacant shall be allotted to the all India candidature Candidates.

### **Very Important Note:-**

Due to Advisory "Break the Chain" (Reference No.2.) issued by Government of Maharashtra on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2021, the following instructions are being shared with all the admitting colleges.

In view of the strict restrictions in the Government circular "Break The Chain" in all cases college should avoid calling the candidates to the colleges for documents verification & admission purpose.

The colleges should verify the documents/credentials through Video Conferencing/ E-Mails/What's App.

On verification, the candidate should pay the seat acceptance fee of Rs. 1000/- through College login, if candidate has not paid the Seat Acceptance fees in any previous round online through candidate's login. Colleges are prohibited from accepting the Seat Acceptance fees again if it is already paid by the candidate through his login.

On payment of the Seat acceptance fee, college should confirm the admissions.  
Colleges are liberty to seek written undertaking from the Candidates.

**The colleges can do the physical verification of the documents after the restrictions are eased.**

**Regarding College fee payment, you can give time to candidates or ask the candidate to deposit in the bank or if the college has any other online fee payment facility they can use that.**

**The colleges strictly warned not to call the candidates in the college premises.**

**It is obligatory on the part of the admitting College to intimate the process of admission to the candidates in the Merit List, via E-mail & SMS both ways.**

**Making Online Admission facilities available to the candidates is the responsibility of the admitting colleges. Communicating On line process of the admission to all the candidates who have given choice/s is also the responsibility of the all colleges.**

**No extension to this round will be given in any case after second reopening Extension Round III.**
